Firstly I would like to welcome John Dearden as our Area Director of Examiners together with Alex Edwards as the Assistant Director John has already mapped out a comprehensive calendar for the next year and I look forward to working with them both.

The last few months have been a busy time for the East we managed to put a Senior Men and Women's team into the National Team Championships held at Walsal this year with men's team reaching the last 8.(A full report can be found elsewhere in this newsletter)

In August I reinstated the Eastern Area Open which was a huge success we had over 120 players 19 of whom were from Kumo's sister club in Belgium Kemzeke, considering this event was in the middle of August we still had some top level players competing from Pinewood, Ealing and JSC to name but a few. The competition was also well supported by Area players many thanks to those who took part.

The next day an International training session was run by David Oates and Mark Purllant with some 70 players attending.

The East was also well represented at the British Masters with Lesley Reid and Braith Bryant taking Gold, Nick Williams, Stuart Appleby and Valdimir Vasekin taking Silver.

We have 3 players ranked in the top 8 Senior Ranking List, Colin Oates, Jonathan Drane and Thomas Turner. Colin Oates represented Great Britain at the World Championships but unfortunately failed to progress.

Congratulations to James Basey-Fisher and Callum Curtis (Pictured on front page) of Black Dog Judo Club who both won a Bronze at the A Band nationals on the 19th September. Black Dog were also responsible for bringing Craig Fallon to our Area for a session enjoyed by some 70 odd area players.

The Area heavily funded 4 of our more promising young players to attend a Training camp in Belgium run by Cedric Taymans in keeping with our policy of player support we are grateful to Paul Nicholson who took our youngsters out to Brussels and spent a week looking after them

We still need table officials and referees to ease the strain on our already overworked volunteers if anyone out there would like to get involved please let me know, there will be a course at Black Dog Judo Club in Bungay on the 30th October.

In the next month or so I will be travelling to Dublin where Area players will be in action at the Irish Open and in the coming months we will have Area seniors fighting in Sweden Finland Holland Belgium Scotland and Japan.

EASTERN AREA 1st Kyu & Dan Grade Promotion information.

The area committee has agreed to hold four contest Dan Grade Promotion examinations at Thetford in 2011 the dates for these are 16th January, 10th April, 3rd July & 9th October 2011.

Booking-in time 12.30 to 1.00pm.

It is hoped that any 1st Kyu & Dan grades that are interested in this type of promotion will support these events along with their coaches, if required we will at these gradings, examine any judoka for their contest Dan grade theory as part of the examination.

The area committee has agreed to a one year trial to supplement the area gradings by hosting contest Dan gradings around the area within 4 designated clubs.

The committee have appointed Mr. Alec Edwards as the Eastern Area assistant director of examiners.

I hope to hold a weekend Technical Dan grade workshop on 29th and 30th January 2011, in Norwich, with grade assessments being held on the Sunday. Then hold a Kata workshop for coaches & Judoka as early as possible after the technical workshop as possible. Should there be the requirement from the area members I would host a second technical workshop later in the year.

The aim is to promote and encourage ALL our area members to fulfil their personal potential by taking part in the BJA promotion systems either by contest or technical examinations by providing the service to allow the individual the opportunity to take part in whichever system they wish.

Anyone wishing to gain the information and requirements to take the technical Dan grade promotion examination can obtain the Technical Dan Grade Examination form from the BJA web site. Only A BJA Senior Examiner can take the technical promotion examination, the grade must be registered with the BJA National Dan Grade Registrar

NATIONAL TEAMS WALSALL July17th

Back in 2007 we fielded a mens team that took gold and a ladies team that won a bronze but there were not too many hopes we could repeat the experience in what was the East's first appearance at the teams in 3 years.

The new 5 person format did little to help as we could not muster a -57k lady from within our 30 or so clubs. Indeed we fielded 2 mums and two relatively inexperienced (at this level) ladies.

They all fought their hearts out but there is no escaping the fact that we never looked like winning a match losing 0-5 1-4 and 1-4 with only Lesley Reed managing a win their other win was a bye.

At this stage a team manager is supposed to say we learnt from this experience and we can build for the future. Well frankly we cannot unless clubs within the East produce more lady players and display them at the Area Championships.

There is always somebody out there who claims they have a player that could have done this or that or I should have contacted so and so. After 20 years on the competition circuit I am sick of hearing nonsense. If any coach out there has ladies that can do better than this team ENTER THEM WHERE WE CAN SEE THEM AT THE AREA CHAMPIONSHIPS IN DECEMBER.

The Ladies team I fought was the best known to me and they took on without flinching full time players and gave their all.

The mens team consisted of 3 full timers and 2 dads and progressed to the last 8 having beaten the South 3-2.

We then lost 0-5 to Scotland in a score line that flattered the Scots as a number of bouts were very close. Could this team have been stronger? The answer is yes but I cannot force players to fight just like my argument with the Ladies unless players fight the Area Championships it is not likely we will fight them in the Teams

3. **JUNIOR REFEREE COURSE AT KIDDERMINSTER - 3rd JULY**

Nicholas Johnson and Adam Pickerill attended and both passed their respective theory and practical assessments. Nicholas is now qualified to level 2 and Adam to level 3. Both are keen to progress to the next level and are seeking practical experience so please contact me if you are running an event at which junior referees can officiate.

4. **EAST AREA CLOSED COMPETITION - 14th AUGUST**

Connor Rainey, 4th mon, put in a good performance as the youngest and least experienced player in the 12 to 15 year old section against green and blue belt graded opponents.

5. **HEART OF ENGLAND, NIA, Birmingham - 5th SEPTEMBER**

Andrew Pickerill entered the U90kg weight category for 16 to 18 year olds and fought his way through to the last 4 but lost the semi final to the eventual gold medallist so collected a bronze medal. Andrew also scored enough points to take his total to 100 for his competitive dan grade subject to passing the theory assessment which he aims to complete later this year.

Felixstowe Judo Club

Felixstowe Judo Club achieves school2dojo Black Belt links

The School 2 Dojo programme links with the BJA Clubmark scheme, an initiative to recognise and reward examples of good practice within clubs that are promoting and delivering judo. The benefits include club promotion, having a recognised standard, increased membership, as well as the development of coaches and volunteers. School 2 Dojo enables schools to actively recognise their links with local judo clubs by being presented with certificates to be displayed within the school which benefits both establishments.

There are three grades within the programme. Yellow is to recognise the initial link. When the relationship is built up, you reach blue which is based on introducing volunteers and bringing them in to a range of courses as well as supporting local clubs. For black a school needs to use communications and contacts within the school to get more people volunteering and on the mat to have a go, then you can have small judo festivals. Black does take a long time to achieve but once you have it you have a good structure and opportunity for competitions which lets children test their ability.

Ultimately the aim is to introduce more children to the sport through the programme, develop their interest and then see them take up the sport at a local club.

David Martin BJA Enjoy Judo Development coach has been running the BJA Enjoy Judo scheme at Deben High school, Felixstowe since January 2007. Currently there are three Enjoy Judo classes afterschool on Mondays and two Wednesday classes.

Sarah Logan SSCo based at Deben High helped organise and obtained funding to allow judo taster sessions to run coached by David Martin at Deben High and local infant and Junior schools in Felixstowe. David Martin has also secured Sports Unlimited funding for spring, summer and autumn terms this year to be used for purchasing BJA licences for beginners.

In addition to the 5 afterschool classes there is also a strong link with Causton Junior school where a Wednesday lunchtime club has been running successfully for 2 years.

David recently spent a day in the school, in addition to his daily classes, delivering taster sessions for all year groups as part of their 'Olympic Day' at the school.

Pupils from the Enjoy Judo classes are now starting to feed into the Felixstowe Judo community club. Felixstowe Judo Club junior member's achieving grading success include, Ben Caldwell 8th Mon, Ben Cattemole 8th Mon, Max Unwin 7th Mon, Conor Warne 2nd Mon and Mark Knights 1st Mon.

Felixstowe Judo club hosted a Junior referee course in November 2009 with Ben Caldwell and Charles Clayton, pupils from Deben High school achieving the Level 1 Junior Referee

award. Both have since competed and officiated at two school judo competitions for the Copleston Sports Partnership, hosted by Felixstowe Judo club during the last 12 months. In addition both pupils also volunteer their time each week helping out at the afterschool clubs on Mondays and Wednesdays.

During the summer holidays Enjoy Judo summer school classes were held weekly, open to beginners, local school and community judo clubs. Felixstowe JC was also in action during July at local sport promotional events including Active Fest, Felixstowe Leisure centre and XtremeFest 2010.



More recently James and Ben achieved medal success at the Eastern Area Open competition, held at Thetford in August which attracted top London clubs and players from Belgium Division one club Kemzeke.

Some visiting Judoka are now attending the Monday Youth & Adult sessions at Felixstowe Judo club for competitive randori and more competitive technical drill sessions. Felixstowe Judo club has an open door policy and welcomes all visitors to train at the club.

Success for Black Dog Judo Club

Four players from Black Dog travelled to Crystal Palace on the 19th Sept to take part in the 10 & 11 yrs nationals. Both Michael and Harry found themselves with tough draws and were unable to progress, but James and Callum demonstrated some excellent Judo and both won bronze medals. This is an outstanding feat for these two players who have only been doing Judo for a year and a half. The exciting thing is there are other members equally keen to compete at such competitions, and it also means we have 4 national medallists in just 2 years!

We will also be sending four players to the nationals at Sheffield where Jack and Elora hope to build on their national medals from last year, and Andrew and Jasper will also be competing. Jasper will be hoping to recreate his performance at the Kent International this year where he won gold along with Jack's bronze. These results are just a sample of how well all the players have performed competitively since the club started.

The club has also held a number of high profile training sessions - open to the whole area, including Craig Fallon and Hungarian world medallist Bernadett Baczko. 130 players took part in Craig's session, which was inspirational! I strongly believe that these sessions are very important to our player's development, and the initiative to build on these with monthly area training is crucial.

The club trains twice a week at 2 different venues, regularly attracting 20 players for the first mat and 35 players for the second mat as well as a number of visiting players from other clubs. We have just started our senior session, which has seen many parents start judo for the first time! We have a great deal of plans for the future but immediately we hope to qualify some in house competition officials allowing us to hold 2 and 3 mat competitions next year. But our most important plan is to keep having fun doing beautiful judo!
